is a volunteer-based literacy program provided by the Cartersville Public Library to help children develop a love of reading through positive reading experiences. Children, ages 4-10, have fun reading with a volunteer. The Library has expanded the Book Buddies program to the Hands of Christ After School Program at First Presbyterian Church in Cartersville on Mondays during the school year. We need adult volunteers to engage in reading sessions with children in grades K-5. The child will read to their Buddy for 15 minutes and receive a FREE book to keep. Through this program, we plan to provide the children with a fun and positive reading experience that will help to strengthen their literacy skills. Volunteers commit to 1-6 weekly sessions of approximately 1 ½ hours per week.
